Jesse Davis has been the director of music ministry at First Baptist Church Pinehurst for the last 10 years. He was on the Music Faculty at the Snyder Memorial Baptist Music Academy in Fayetteville from 2005 - 2015, while still continuing to perform classical piano internationally. His wife Leslie is currently the pianist at Snyder Memorial, having been their organist for the past 10 years. Jesse and Leslie are both talented musicians but believe their calling to be teaching the value of music as a ministry.

Leslie and Jesse married in 1999 and received their Masters of Music from Baylor University in 2001. Jesse and Leslie met while undergraduate students at the University of North Carolina School of the Arts. Jesse is in the final stage of completing his Master of Divinity from Southeastern Seminary.

The Davises have three children: Thomas (15), John (9) and Victoria (4). Jesse grew up and was baptized in Washington, graduated from Washington High School, and studied piano with Mrs. Edith Bond and Dr. Charles Bath of ECU.
