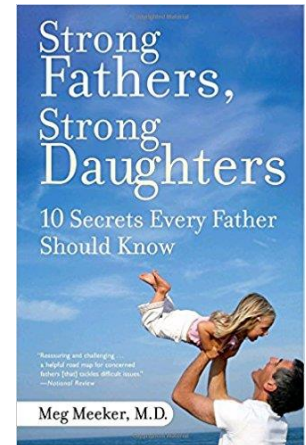


Youth
