Swazi Hunger Fund ~ A Month of Swazi Meals for \$70

With the current economic shutdown in Eswatini, our Swazi friends are experiencing devastating loss. What were already meager sources of income have dried up, directly affecting resources for food and other essentials. In the words of Wayne Myers, "I have often seen hunger in Eswatini, but this time it is much more widespread and more desperate."

A plan has been put in place utilizing our local Swazi pastors to get basic foods to needy families. \$70 will feed a Swazi family for a month and through our Swazi Partnership, we hope to supply at least 200 families for 3 months and see them through their winter season.

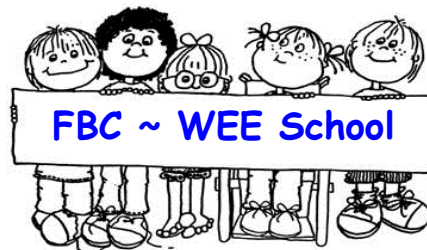
