THE TRIUMPHAL ENTRY

As we move to the "Passion Week," Jesus' final entry into Jerusalem takes on major significance even as it also raises many questions in our minds:

- Why, after walking everywhere He went and now, less than two miles from His destination, is He going to ride into the city on a borrowed donkey?
- Why would the crowd wave palm branches? (John 12:13)
- Why would the disciples throw "...their own clothes on the colt..." and the crowd "...spread their clothes on the road...?" (Luke 19:35 & 36)
- What was the meaning of what they were shouting? (Mt. 21:9; Lk. 19:38; Mark 11:10)
- How could such a celebration take place and then, just a few days later, we see the crowd shouting, "Crucify Him, crucify Him!" (Luke 23:21)
- What do we learn about the heart of God revealed in Jesus' weeping over the city?

Mark Moore in his *The Chronological Life of Christ* (1997) p. 497 states, "On the one hand you have the praise of the people, the sick being healed and children worshipping God. On the other hand, you have the religious leaders wanting to put a stop to it because it is out of their control."

This event is rich in the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies, 1st century Jewish culture and worldview, and the practice of Second Temple Period Judaism. As Jesus was teaching His disciples of His day, so we as His disciples today can learn from Him.
