Born in 1955 in Hamburg, Germany, Stephan Möller received degrees in piano and orchestral conducting at the Mozarteum University in Salzburg, Austria. For 30 years Möller taught at the University for Music and Performing Arts in Vienna, Austria. Currently, he teaches on the piano faculty of the Richard Wagner Conservatory in Vienna. He first gained success as a prizewinner at the 1985 International Beethoven Piano Competition in Vienna. His concerts have taken him to Japan, China, North and South America as well as all over Europe. He worked with Herbert von Karajan and other world-renowned conductors at the Salzburg Festival from 1983-1989.

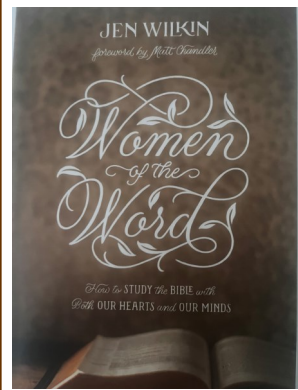
