Hello FBC,

"And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth." (John 1:14) I do hope that as you have gone through this week, you have thought about Jesus in a deeper way. John saw that in Christ, everything God has ever spoken would be fulfilled in Him, either in His first coming or His second. The gospel of John gives us key details about His first coming, and in Revelation, John sees details about His second coming. No one was better suited to tell us about Jesus, than this apostle who has seen His glory both in real life and in the revelation of the future kingdom. For us, we should pray to be able to see Jesus the way that John has, to see Him as prophet, priest and king. Jesus lived the life that we cannot, in submission to God's law, so that we have a high priest who can sympathize with our temptations and weaknesses. (Heb 4:15)

This week we will finish up the prologue of the gospel. The prologue is a section of the story that comes first to explain other events that will take place in the rest of the narrative. In these closing verses of the prologue, verses 14-18, we will see John compare himself and Jesus, Moses and Jesus, and end where He began: that He was with God and is the only one who has ever seen Him. I hope that each of you will spend time each week reviewing our scriptures and gaining understanding in our Lord, the more you know Him, the more you will love Him, and the more you love Him, the more you will become like Him.
