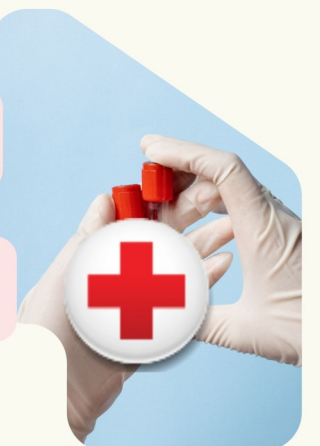

A letter from the Pastor

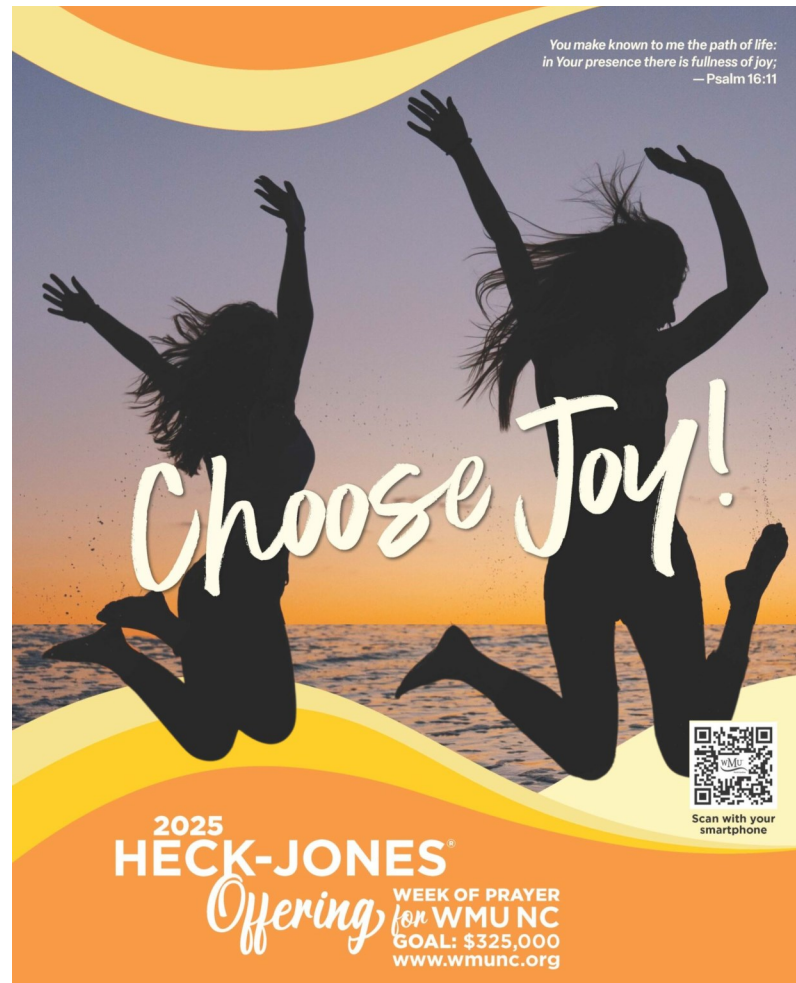
Greetings FBC,

I pray that each of you has enjoyed our brief look into the subject of worship. I also pray that all of us have gained new insight into the means and methods of the type of worship God deserves. This past week, as Isaiah gazed into heaven and saw the Lord seated upon His throne, he understood that God is the King of kings, holy and eternal.
