Greetings First Baptist Family,

I hope everyone is enjoying this beautiful spring weather, apart from the blanket of pollen. It is hard to believe but April is here, and Easter is right around the corner. I hope everyone enjoyed our combined service last week; it is so nice to have our church family together at one specific time.

We have several events coming up this month that we all need to be aware of. This Sunday evening at 5:30pm will be our Easter family night. There will be a worship service then food and fun in the family life center. Also, coming up is the youth prayer breakfast April 14-17. On Thursday April 17th we will have our Maundy Thursday service in the sanctuary (time will be provided next week). And lastly, we will celebrate resurrection Sunday on April 20th at our normal worship times, 8:30am and 11:00am.
